In addition to the above closed holidays, each employee will also be permitted to avail himself / herself any of two holidays to be chosen out of the Restricted Holidays during the year 2015.

Permission to avail oneself of the Restricted Holidays should be applied for in writing in advance and will normally be granted by the superior officer competent to grant Casual Leave except when the presence of an individual employee is considered necessary in the exigencies of Govt. Work. A record will be maintained in respect of persons availing themselves of Restricted Holidays during recess.

Field personnel are not governed by the instructions of 5 days a week for the duration of the field duties. The three national holidays viz., 26th January, 15th August and 2nd October will be observed as closed holidays by all the personnel in field. The other Gazetted Holidays will be working days for field staff in the field for which may avail LL during recess after the field.

With regard to other Gazetted Holiday foregone during the field operations, the field staff be compensated by granting equivalent number of days during the following days. The compensatory off will not be allowed to be carried forwarded to the next year. The national Holidays viz. 26th January, 15th August and 2nd October will be observed as closed holidays by all the personnel whether they are in the field or at recess or at headquarters.

Adequate arrangements will be made for dealing with urgent work on all holidays and a holiday roster will be maintained for this purpose. Persons so detailed on duty should, as soon as possible, be granted Lieu Leave on a subsequent working day to compensate for working on a holiday. This Lieu Leave should be taken as soon as convenient after the holiday in question (within 15 days) and should not be allowed to accumulate. Such compensatory leave will not be granted to Gazetted Officers.
