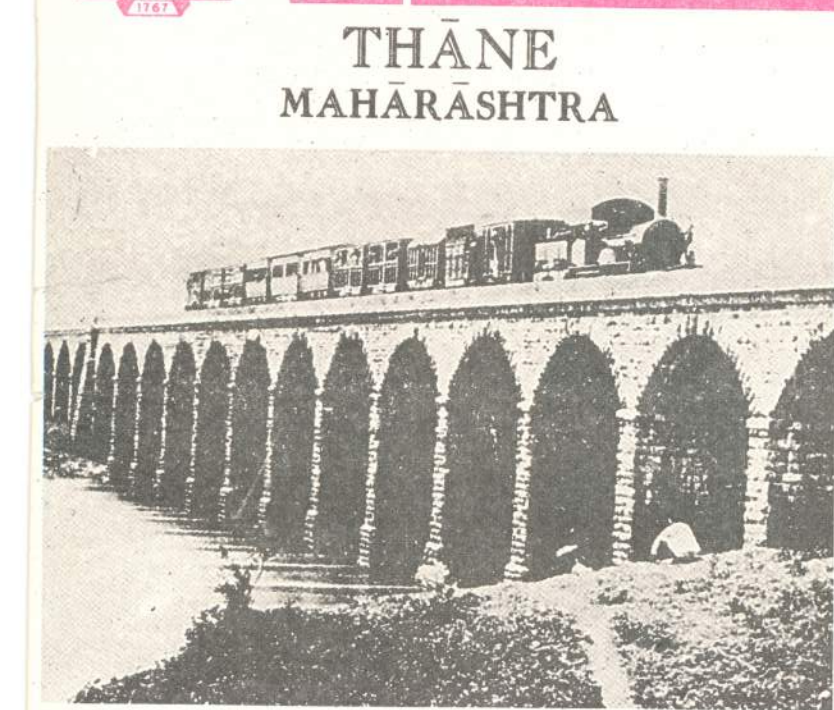

THANE was known in the past as SHIRDI and was the headquarters of Kanak-Kingdom of Shivajiraj. The fort, Parbhurji, Chhatrapati, a few dilapidated old remains, that go to show THANE was once a great city. In India, first train was run from MUMBAI to THANE on 6th April, 1853. Now, it is a famous railway station on Central Railway route located at a distance of 34 km. from MUMBAI. The location of old THANE has undergone a radical change. Beyond the old parts of erstwhile town, it is now a very well-planned city with its suburbs extending beyond its former limits.
