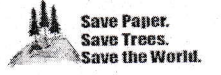

**SUB: RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BOARD OF OFFICERS FOR
COMPASSIONATE APPOINTMENT**

Sir,

I have the honour to invite your kind attention to your letter No.स्था.3-5117/1869-A-Policy dated 26/27-08-2019 in which the list of applicants for compassionate appointment under 5% quota was provided to the Board with other relevant records. The guidelines/instructions issued from time to time by DoPT as well as important Court Judgements were kept in mind while considering all 54 cases of compassionate appointment.

2. The Board of Officers, constituted vide your Department Order No.E3-43/1869-A/Policy dated 24-01-2019, arranged all 54 empanelled cases in decreasing order of preference e.g. name at Merit Position No. 1 is the most deserving case and at Merit Position No. 54 is the least deserving case, after thorough scrutiny. As per available vacancies under 5% quota the Board has recommended 13 candidates for compassionate appointment. The list is enclosed for your perusal and further necessary action, please.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BOARD FOR COMPASSIONATE APPOINTMENT

1. Authority:

The following Board of Officers was constituted vide SG's Departmental Order No. E3-43/1869-A/Policy dated 24-01-2019 to consider the cases for compassionate appointment:

(i)	Shri Nitin Joshi, Deputy Surveyor General, SGO	Chairman
(ii)	Shri Dhiraj Shah, Director, NPG	Member
(iii)	Col Rakesh Singh, Director, MA&DC	Member

2. Panel & Vacancies:

06 vacancies of Group 'C' (VT TTT'B') and 07 vacancies of MTS are existing under compassionate appointment and 54 empanelled cases were made available to the Board vide SG's letter No. E3-5117/1869-A-Policy dated 26/27-08-2019.

3. Details of Meeting:

The Board met on 3rd, 4th and 16th September, 2019 at SGO during which empanelled cases were thoroughly examined and considered for recommending the most deserving cases. As per the list forwarded by the SG's Office, there were total 54 cases to be considered for compassionate appointment.

4. Criteria Adopted:

(i). The efficacy of the Scheme is based on its transparency. It is this aspect, which is foremost kept in view by the Committee while considering a request for appointment on Compassionate grounds. A balanced and objective assessment of the financial condition of the family has to be done to assess the degree of indigence among all the applicants considered for compassionate appointment within the prescribed ceiling of 5% of the direct recruitment vacancies. To achieve the objective of the scheme of the Compassionate Appointment and to ensure complete transparency and to decide merits of the cases, all the eligible applicants were assessed on a **100-point scale on various parameters as suggested by Government of India, Ministry of Science & Technology, Department of Science & Technology vide O.M. No.12012/02/2019-Estt.II dated 20-08-2019.** Following factors were considered by the board in respect of empanelled cases to ascertain the financial condition and essential needs of the family of the deceased government servants:-

- i) Family Pension
- ii) Terminal Benefits
- iii) Leftover Service of the Deceased govt. servant.
- iv) Number of Unmarried Daughters
- v) Number of Minor Children
- vi) Number of Other Dependents (excluding unmarried daughters and minor children)
- vii) Monthly Income excluding family pension
- viii) Moveable/Immovable Property
- ix) Liabilities

5. After considering all cases, it was found that most of the applicants have stated that they have no immovable/moveable property. Similarly many candidates have also written that dependents of the deceased govt. servants who are even more than 25 years of age are unemployed which also includes married sons. At the time of death, the deceased govt. servants were posted in different offices of Survey of India, which are located in different states. Now the families of the deceased govt. servants are staying in various villages and towns spread all over India.

6. The family pension received by the deceased govt. servants can assist in the basic survival of the family in most of the cases except in those cases where minor dependents are more. However, if the employment under Scheme for compassionate appointment is given to a family member of the deceased govt. servant, it will improve the financial condition of the family.

7. The scheme of appointment on compassionate grounds has been envisaged with the overall objective of granting compassionate appointment to enable the family to tide over the sudden crisis and to relieve the family in emergency. The scheme does not necessarily imply that dependant of each and every deceased Govt. servant will be offered appointment on compassionate grounds. It is pertinent to mention here that quota prescribed for the purpose of compassionate appointment is only 5% of the total Direct Recruitment vacancies occurring in a year in Gp. 'C' & 'D' posts.

8. D.O.P.T. has instructed vide O.M. No.14014/23/99-Estt.(D), dated 3rd December,1999 and O.M. No.14014/18/2000-Estt.(D) dated 22nd June,2001 that the Committee prescribed for considering a request for appointment on compassionate grounds should take into account the position regarding availability of vacancy for such appointment and it should recommend appointment on compassionate grounds only in a really deserving case and only if vacancy meant for appointment on compassionate grounds will be available, within a year, that too within the ceiling of 5% of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota.

9. In view of the above, the Board have awarded points to the candidates on different parameters following the criteria mentioned in para 4 and arranged all enclosed 54 empanelled cases in decreasing order of preference e.g. Name at Merit Position No. 1 is the most deserving case and at Merit Position No. 54 is the least deserving case. The list of such candidates is enclosed as Annexure 'A'.

10. The cases at Merit Position No. 1 to 13 (13 cases) of enclosed list are recommended for compassionate appointment, being most deserving to the extent of available vacancies under 5% quota.


11. The cases at Merit Position No. 20, 27 and 52 were considered as per directions of Hon'ble CAT as mentioned in SGO letter no. E3-5117/1869-A-Policy dated 26/27-08-2019, but could not find place in most deserving 13 cases. These cases are recommended to be closed now.

12. Balance 38 cases are recommended to be considered next time.


